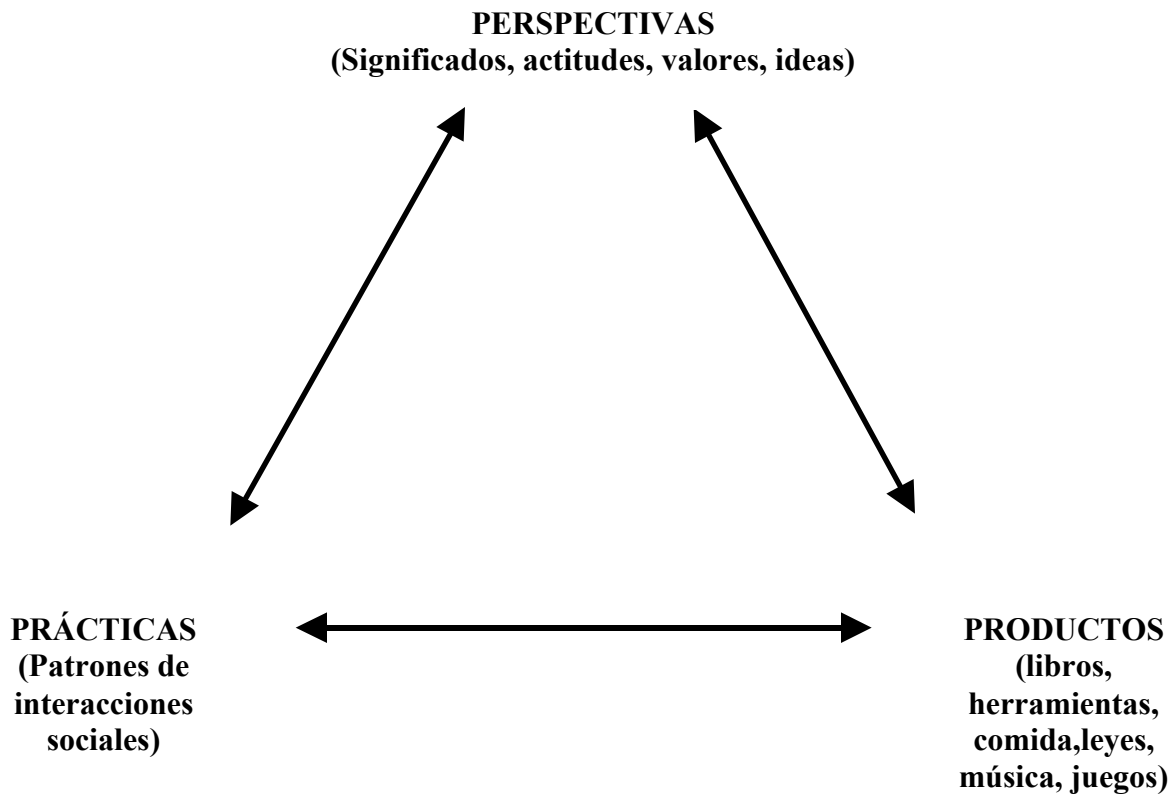


El Triángulo de la Cultura



The term “culture” is generally understood to include the philosophical perspectives, the behavioral practices, and the products—both tangible and intangible—of a society. The diagram illustrates how the products and practices are derived from the philosophical perspectives that form the world view of a cultural group. It also shows how these three components of culture are closely interrelated (p. 47, *Standards for Foreign Language Learning in the 21st Century*).
